The Kingston Arts Council Announces the 2017 City of Kingston Arts Fund Program

The Kingston Arts Council (KAC) is now accepting applications for the 2017 City of Kingston Arts Fund (CKAF). The total amount available in 2017 is \$564,000. Administered by the Kingston Arts Council on behalf of the City of Kingston, the program is made up of two funding streams: Operating Grants and Project Grants. The program provides grants to local arts organizations and projects to foster creativity at all levels and enrich how Kingston residents experience and engage with the arts.

CKAF is intended to nurture the capacity of artists and the arts sector in Kingston, while fostering creativity, encouraging social cohesion, enhancing quality of life and stimulating economic development through direct investment. CKAF aims to bring provincial, national and international recognition to Kingston as a centre for arts and culture and to align Kingston arts funding with that of comparable cities around Ontario.
