An Isabel and Tett Fundraiser

The Isabel and the Tett are reaching out to invite you to once again be a part of our Art for All fundraiser.

Benefiting the Isabel Bader Centre for the Performing Arts and the Tett Centre for Creativity and Learning, funds raised will be used to present collaborative community programming within the two spaces. Community programming is the heart of both centres' strategic focus, so it only made sense to take this opportunity to elevate this partnership.

What is Art for All?

Art for All is a balloted auction on all forms of art. The Isabel was the benefactor of this event last year, organized by Catie Allen and friends. This year the Isabel and the Tett Centre for Creativity and Learning have partnered to present the event to share the incredible works of art in numerous forms with the community and raise funds for collaborative programming at the Isabel and the Tett.

How does it work?

The Isabel and Tett curation team will be accepting art submissions. The artist sets the price of the work. The artwork will be displayed in the Isabel Bader Centre for the Performing Arts Art and Media Lab from Tuesday October 10, 2023, until Saturday October 14, 2023. Patrons will be invited to come and see the works available and can submit a ballot on all pieces they are interested in purchasing. On Saturday October 14, 2023, a draw event will be held at the Isabel. The hosts will draw a ballot on each piece to see who gets the opportunity to purchase the piece at the set price. The buyer pays the set price for the piece (set by the artist, inclusive of HST if applicable). Fifty percent (50%) of the sale price (less HST) is a donation to the Isabel and Tett Collaborative Programming Fund and the other fifty percent (50%) is paid to the artist.

What can be donated?

We are asking for original art and/or creative experiences with a minimum value of \$150. The art/creative experience could be in many forms including visual, theatre, performance, music, dance, classes, etc. We ask that all visual art pieces are delivered ready to hang and include packaging material. Artwork will be displayed in the Art and Media Lab during the viewing period, in the Lobby during the reception, and will be rewrapped upon purchase. Participating artists and arts organizations are welcome to include their personal business cards within the packaging.

How does the artist get paid and receive a tax receipt for their donation?

Following the event, Queen's University will issue a cheque for the full amount of the sale to the artist. The artist is then asked to donate fifty percent (50%) of the sale to the Isabel and Tett Collaborative Programming Fund (link to be provided on the Isabel website). When that donation is made, the artist

will receive a tax receipt from Queen's University. Tax receipts are issued at the end of the tax year. Donations must be made by December 31, 2023, and all receipts will be issued by February 29, 2024.

How do I participate?

You are invited to submit to Janelle MacPherson-Kenney at the Isabel with the below details.

Please note that submissions will be accepted at the discretion of the Tett and Isabel curatorial team.

A formal acceptance will be sent with final details including the delivery day and any further information required.

Submission emails must be received by Friday, September 29th at 5pm

Email your submission using the subject line: Art for All 2023 Artist Name Name of Piece"

Please include the following information:

- 1. Artist name
- 2. Name of piece
- 3. Description of piece i.e., Oil on canvas
 - *If your item includes classes or is a performance piece, please specify the timeframe it must be redeemed within, i.e., Private performance by artist to be held between October 2023 and April 2024 on an agreed upon date by both the artist and purchaser
- 4. Please attach a jpeg of your piece
- 5. Size of the piece and how it will be displayed i.e., hung art, requires a plinth, etc.
- 6. Value/selling price of the piece (value determined by the artist)
 *Please note that all prices should be inclusive of HST if applicable. Queen's will include the HST amount on the cheque to the artist and it will be the responsibility of the artist to remit the HST.
